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## **ANNUAL REPORT 2014-15**

Pavai Arts and Science College for Women, affiliated to Periyar University, Salem was established in the year 2009. The college offers nine Under Graduate courses, four Post Graduate courses and three M.Phil courses. We go all-out to develop self-reliance in the minds of our students to enable them to become good cultured and disciplined students.

### **ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES**

Various events like seminars, paper presentation, quiz program and competitions at regular intervals are organized by the Departments of English, Maths, Commerce and Computer Science to boost the spirit of power, interest, involvement and healthy competition among the students.

Wipro campus recruitment drive was held on 27.01.2015 and 3 of our students were placed in Wipro. Techmahindra Recruitment drive was held on 10.02.2015 and 5 students of our college were placed.
